Walter Langley R.I.	1852-1922. Pioneer of the Newlyn Colony of Artists. Lived here from 1896 until 1919	Westbourne House, Alexandra Road, Penzance	29 September 2014
Harold Harvey	1874-1941. Artist of the Newlyn School. Born here on 20 May 1874	20 North Parade, Penzance	29 September 2014
John Coulson Tregarthen	1854-1933. Educationalist, writer and field naturalist. Born in Penzance and lived here in 1871	'The Tremenheere' – Wetherspoons, Market Jew Street, Penzance	31 March 2015
John Divane VC	1823-1888. Awarded the VC for distinguished gallantry during the Indian Mutiny, 10 September 1857. Died here on 1 December 1888 and is buried in Penzance Cemetery.	35 New Street, Penzance	26 June 2015
Dylan Thomas	1914-1953. Poet and writer. Married Caitlin Macnamara in this house on 11 July 1937.	Phoenix House, 8 Parade Street, Penzance	11 July 2015
